TRAIT	AGE RANGE	NOTES
<b>BIRTH WEIGHT</b>	<b>WITHIN 24 HOURS</b>	Using a scale.
<b>CALVING EASE</b>	<b>WITHIN 24 HOURS</b>	<b>1</b> = Unassisted <b>2</b> = Easy Pull <b>3</b> = Hard Pull <b>4</b> = Surgical assistance <b>5</b> = Mal-presentation <b>6</b> = Elective Surgical
<b>WEANING WEIGHT (200D)</b>	<b>80-300 DAYS OF AGE</b>	Using a scale.
<b>DOCILITY</b>	<b>60-400 DAYS OF AGE</b>	It is recommended to be recorded when animals are being weighed at 200 days. <b>1</b> = Docile <b>2</b> = Restless <b>3</b> = Nervous <b>4</b> = Flighty <b>5</b> = Aggressive  Testing method needs to be recorded when submitting scoring - <b>Yard</b> = <b>TY</b> or <b>Crush</b> = <b>TC</b> .
<b>YEARLING WEIGHT (400D)</b>	<b>301-500 DAYS OF AGE</b>	Using a scale.

<b>SCROTAL CIRCUMFERENCE</b>	<b>300-700 DAYS OF AGE</b>	Scrotal circumference should be recorded when bulls are being weighed at 400 days.
<b>FINAL WEIGHT (600D)</b>	<b>501-900 DAYS OF AGE</b>	Using a scale.
<b>MATURE COW WEIGHT</b>	<b>870-3900 DAYS OF AGE</b>	Cow must have had a calf with a valid 200d weight recorded and within two weeks of each other.
